Bethany Lutheran College was founded in 1911 as the Bethany Ladies College. In 1927, what is now the Evangelical Lutheran Synod purchased the college and created a co-educational high school and junior college. In 1969 the high school was closed and Bethany operated strictly as a junior college until 1996 when it became a full four year college offering both Associates and Baccalaureate degrees.
